The following is the city ordinance relating to cabs: For cabs or vehicles drawn by one horse, from 6 a. m. to 9 p. m. for conveying one passenger one mile or part thereof, 50 cents; for each additional passenger, 50 cents; for each additional half mile or part thereof, 50 cents per passenger. From 9 p. m. to 6 a. m., for conveying one passenger one mile...



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
