On March 28, 2012, we issued our final report on the Federal Aviation Administrations (FAA) Systems Engineering 2020 (SE-2020) contracts. SE-2020 is a portfolio of contracts that FAA is using to obtain professional and technical services to support its development and implementation of NextGen. FAA awarded seven SE-2020 base contracts between April and October 2010, which have a cumulative maximum value of 7.3 billion-the largest award in FAAs history. We assessed whether FAA: (1) manages its SE-2020 contract costs effectively; and (2) uses sound contracting practices to select contractors and oversee their performance.
