They are twenty-seven in number, and embrace a wide range of research, from the origin of the earth, the nature of the colors of vegetables and insects, the analysis of minerals and chemicals, to an improved method of constructing lamps or of making coffee. Some of these papers were translated into French by the author and others, and published in the Journal de Physique, de Chimie, et d Histoire Naturelle, etc. These writings of Smithson prove conclusively his scientific character and his claim to distinction as a contributor to knowledge.
